Civil Weddings & Partnerships

Civil marriage and partnership ceremonies can be performed in one of two licensed rooms at The George so you can spend your whole day at the hotel and no one needs to be concerned about getting from the church or register office to the reception.

The Garrick Suite accommodates up to 90 guests, while the Charter Room accommodates a maximum of 35 for the ceremony. For your civil ceremony the hotel provides the hire of a licensed room for the ceremony plus the hire of a smaller room for the private interview prior to your marriage.

The first step in arranging a civil marriage or partnership at The George is to provisionally reserve a date and time for your ceremony with us. You should then contact Lichfield Register Office in order to make a booking for the Register staff to attend.

Booking Terms & Conditions

All reservations for civil weddings and wedding receptions are accepted subject to the following terms & conditions:

Booking

Once you have decided on a suitable date and have checked availability with The George, you can then make a provisional booking. The provisional booking will be held for 14 days, after which time the date will be released.

To confirm the booking we must receive the following:

Written confirmation.

A signed copy of our terms and conditions.

The appropriate non-refundable and non-transferable deposit.

Deposits and Payments

Please note that all amounts pre-paid will be non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances. All prices are subject to increase at the discretion of The George and may be changed without prior notice.

- A non-refundable deposit of £500 is to be paid within 14 days of the provisional booking being made.
- 50% of the outstanding estimated balance is payable 6 months prior to the date of the function.
- The final balance is payable 1 calendar month prior to the date of the function.
- A final invoice, inclusive of any additional expenses, will then be issued after the wedding and this should be paid within 7 days.

Number of Guests

A minimum number of adult guests will be agreed and stated on your contract. Please note that you will be charged according to this required minimum number if your final number drops below the agreed minimum. The final number of guests must be confirmed to us at least 14 days prior to your wedding.

Cancellation policy

If you cancel your booking at any time you will forfeit your initial deposit. If you cancel within 6 months of the confirmed date of your wedding, you will forfeit all deposits and pre-payments made up to the date of the cancellation and we reserve the right to make a cancellation charge of 65% of the minimum contracted amount (which will include accommodation, room hire and all food and beverage), less all deposits. Any cancellations must be confirmed to The George in writing. We highly recommend that you take out an insurance policy to insure your wedding against cancellation.

The George reserves the right to cancel the booking if:

Any part of the hotel is closed or otherwise unavailable due to circumstances outside the hotel's control.

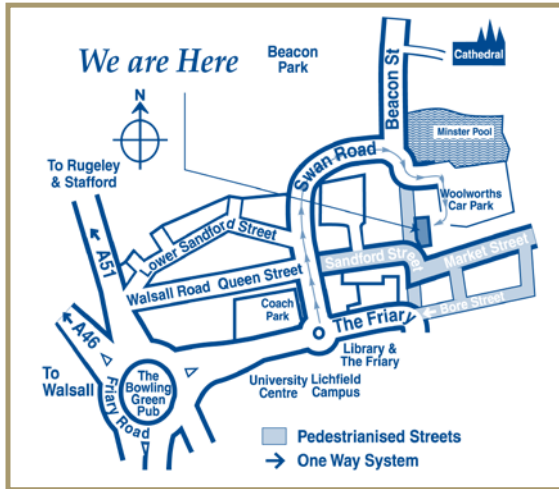
Either party becomes insolvent, or in the case of an individual, becomes subject to a bankruptcy petition.

The booking may damage the reputation of the hotel. In these circumstances you are entitled to a refund of any advance payment, but The George would not have any other liability.

Damage and Loss

Whilst you and your guests are at The George we ask that you make every effort to safeguard the fixtures and fittings. Please note that any damage caused will be charged for in full to the person in whose name the booking was made. Offensive or illegal behaviour may result in individuals or the entire party being asked to leave the premises, in which case no refund will be made.

The George can not accept liability for loss or damage to your or your guests' property.



Once in Lichfield, the hotel is clearly signposted via brown signs.

From North-West, Stafford A51 via Rugeley to Lichfield. At roundabout (Bowling Green in the centre) take the first exit, followed by the first exit on to Swan Road. ***Where the road bends left into Beacon Street, turn right (signposted for the public car park). As you enter the car park right turn and the hotel car park is on the right.**

From North-East, Derby A38 past Burton, then take A5127 into Lichfield. Go over two sets of traffic lights. After the next set of traffic lights (past the railway station) turn right. At small roundabout turn right and proceed as above.*

From South-West, M5 Join M42 at Junction 4a. At Junction 9 either take the M6 Toll (instructions are shown below) or take the A446 and proceed as "From South East".

From South-East, London (avoiding M6 Toll) Leave M6 at Junction 4 and follow A446 for 10 miles. At the large roundabout take the third exit onto A38. At the roundabout go straight over onto A5206. Go over two sets of traffic lights. At the small roundabout, turn right and proceed as above.*

From the M6 Toll

From the North: Join the M6 Toll at Junction 11a of the M6. Exit at T5 on to the A5148. Take the first exit to the roundabout on to the A5206. Go over two sets of traffic lights. At the small roundabout, turn right and proceed as above.*

From the South: Join the M6 Toll at Junction 7a of the M42 or Junction 4a of the M6. Exit at T4. At the roundabout take the second exit on to the A38. At the next roundabout go straight over on to the A5206 and proceed as above.*
