



RESPONSIBLE VISITOR CHARTER

At Webb Hotels we have made a commitment to reduce our impact on the environment wherever we can and we would value your support in this, whether you are staying at the hotels or attending an event.

This charter sets out a number of simple steps that you can take as hotel guests, organisers, visitors and delegates to help us make a difference.



1. Conserve energy

- Help us to reduce our consumption of energy and to keep our prices low by switching off lights and closing windows if the heating or air conditioning is on.
- Turn off all electrical equipment when not in use and avoid leaving computers, projectors and TVs on standby or adaptors plugged in but not connected.



2. Give the car a rest

- Controversial maybe, but why not leave the car behind, even if it's just for a day? Walk, catch the bus, take the train or cycle to us instead! Our reception team will be delighted to provide you with details of the local bus and train services.



3. Shop local

- Insist on using re-useable bags; better still bring your own!



4. Reduce, re-use, recycle

- Recycle as much as you can; hand your unwanted paper to a member of staff or leave it next to your bin and we will happily recycle it for you.
- Consider providing delegate information on memory sticks made from recycled products.



5. Be water wise

- We have fitted water saving devices wherever we can, but we ask you to support our policy by
- Turning off all taps when not in use.
 - Re-using towels if you are staying for more than one night.



6. Respect and enjoy our natural surroundings
